Summer Camp Participants!

Tentative Camp Periods:

1st Camp: July 13 to 26 – GuangXi
Middle School

2nd Camp: July 14 to 26 – Hainan
High School

3rd Camp: Aug 3 to 16 – GuangXi
High School

4th Camp: Aug 4 to 15 – Hainan
Elementary School – need Mandarin support

Estimated cost: CAN/US\$ 950 to 1,000
depending on the destination.

This cost includes:

- ☺ Travel expenses - Hong Kong to/from service area
- ☺ Medical and travel insurance in China
- ☺ Food and board in China
- ☺ Activity expenses in China

Other costs at your own expenses include:

- ☺ Return air ticket from host country to Hong Kong
- ☺ A visa to China

You will need to arrive to Hong Kong two days before the camp period for preparation and need one day after camp for debriefing.

Canada tax deduction receipt will be issued for the above expenses.
